



ReFlex Route 62 Hopkins

The ReFlex Route 62 is a new kind of service The COMET is offering.

- It is a hybrid of a flex route that makes some scheduled stops and demand response (like DART) that allows for scheduled pickups. That's how we got the name ReFlex: Response Flex!
 - Route 62 serves McEntire Produce twice per day with scheduled connections to The 601 to get passengers to work in the morning and home again in the evening. It also makes scheduled stops to the Alvin S. Glenn Detention Center to get people to fixed-route service.
 - Lastly there are scheduled stops to the Food Lion on Garner's Ferry.
- Anyone in the flex zone can schedule pickups by 5 P.M. the day before to go to the Walmart on Garner's Ferry—the end of line point for The 401 on Garner's Ferry and/or the end of The 601 on Bluff Road, or anywhere else in the zone for work, shopping, or recreation.

Fare

- The fare is the same as the rest of the fixed-route system and All-day, 5-day, and 7-day passes can be purchased on route 62 buses. Unlike DART, there are no eligibility requirements. A passenger must be picked up inside the zone.



Customers can purchase All-day, 5-day, 7-day and 31-Day passes at the Customer Service Desk of the North Main and Devine Street Piggly Wiggly. Piggly Wiggly accepts cash, checks, debit/credit cards and Greenbacks.

The COMET does not issue transfers.

All fares can be purchased at the farebox, except a 31-day card, which is available at the transfer center. The 31-day fare-card is your best value. Please tell your bus driver what type of fare media you would like **before** purchasing your fare.

Free and Half Fare:

Children 15 and younger ride The COMET for free. Children 39 inches tall or smaller do not need identification to ride for free; children taller than 39 inches require a The COMET-issued ID card to ride for free. To pay the half fare on the bus, seniors (65+) must show a state-issued ID; Medicare recipients must show a Medicare Card and a state-issued ID; persons with disabilities must have a The COMET-issued HALF PASS ID (for disability application call 803-255-7133). All transit vehicles are ADA accessible.

Half Pass Program

The COMET now has a program for half price media. Anyone may purchase half fare cards but passengers must have a The COMET-issued ID card to use them. ID's are issued by appointment at the Lowell C. Spires, Jr. Regional Transit Facility (3613 Lucius Road, Route 6). Persons meeting the following criteria may get a The COMET ID:

Type of Identification required for ID

Youth*	State-issued ID or birth certificate with parent's State-issued ID or guardianship papers and guardian's State-issued ID.
Persons with disability	The COMET-issued special needs card and State-issued ID
Medicare	Medicare card and State-issued ID
Seniors (65+)	State-issued ID
Veterans	Military ID card or DD-214 with State-issued ID

*Children taller than 39 inches but 15 and younger ride free with The COMET ID, 16 & 17 year old passengers ride half fare with The COMET ID.
